The Joint Health and Safety Committee (JHSC) plays a vital role in fostering a safe and healthy workplace by promoting compliance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA). This includes obtaining and sharing relevant health and safety information, consulting with both workers and employers to address safety concerns and actively participating in workplace inspections and incident investigations. By identifying actual and potential hazards, the JHSC makes informed recommendations to enhance workplace safety and works towards eliminating risks to ensure a secure and compliant work environment for all.
